

MEC Makamu held a session with Community Development Workers.

Mogalakwena - As part of the Department's initiative to improve and reinforce its quality assurance on service delivery, MEC Makamu met with Community Development Workers (CDWs) in Waterberg District to close the gaps which hinders service delivery and to address ways and means which will enable service delivery to reach communities with ease.

Speaking during the meeting held at Mokopane on Monday, 19 October 2020, MEC Makamu commended them for the hard work they display in serving communities even in the most difficult sensitive terrain.
