Bids are hereby invited from interested service providers with CIDB grading of 6CE or higher for construction of Nkowankowa taxi rank. Bid documents are obtainable at the Finance Department – Supply Chain Management of Greater Tzaneen Municipality, Agatha Street, upon a non-refundable fee of R250.00 per document payable at the Revenue Offices: Civic Centre, Agatha Street.

Interested service providers must give proof of the following documents to avoid disqualification:

- Key personnel experience (attach CV and certified qualifications)
- Certified ID copies
- Company registration/CK form
- Original Tax Clearance Certificate
- Relevant CIDB grading of 6CE or higher
- Proof of work experience (attach appointment letters and completion certificate)
- Equipment/Plant (attach proof of ownership/lease agreement) and bank rating (attach bank letter)
- Original or certified copy of B-BBEE Certificate.

Completed bid documents with attachments must be in a sealed envelope and deposited into the bid box of Greater Tzaneen Municipality, Civic Centre, Agatha Street, marked as “Bid No: SCMU 01/2016”, postal address and contact details of the bidder.

Bid documents will be available on 22 March 2016.

A compulsory briefing session and site inspection will be held on 31 March 2016 at 10:00 at the Old Fire Department, Civic Centre, Agatha Street.

Closing date: 15 April 2016 at 12:00. Public bid opening will be held at the Council Chambers immediately after closing.

Evaluation of Bids

NB: The evaluation of bids will be conducted in two stages. First stage will be the assessment of functionality as follows: Company experience = 40 points, bank rating = 10 points, plant and equipment = 20 points, key personnel experience = 30 points; only bidders that obtain 70 points will be evaluated further in terms of the 90/10 preference point scoring system, where 90 points will be allocated for price only and 10 points will be allocated based on the Broad-based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) status level of contributor. Contract period is 7 (seven) months.
