Closing date: 8 December 2017 at 12:00. Public bid opening will be held at the Council Chambers immediately after closing.

Evaluation of bids: The evaluation of bid will be conducted in two stages. First stage it be the assessment of functionality as follows: Work experience (40) points, financial bank rating (10) points, plant & equipment (20) points, locality within Mopani District (30) points.

Thereafter only bidders that obtain 70 points on functionality will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference point scoring system, where 80 points will be allocated for price and 20 points allocated based on the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) status level of contributor
