The reduction in the INEP Grant allocation and the reprioritizing of projects in line with the revised amount will be addressed in the 2020/2021 Adjustment Budget.

B. That Council takes note that government gazette no 43450 issued by National Treasury on the 24th of June 2020 in which Council is informed that the Equitable share allocation will be increased from R414 million to R506 million.

The increase in the equitable share allocation will be addressed in the 2020/2021 adjustment budget.

- 4. That the Final 2020/2021 tariff listing for municipal services be approved, including the explanatory notes of revenue and expenditure increases.
- 5. That it be noted that the final 2020/2021 Estimates will after approval by the Council in terms of section 22 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, be submitted to National Treasury and the Provincial Treasury, together with the quality certificate approved by the accounting officer.

- 6. That an amount of R8 961 106.41 be allocated to GTEDA Municipal entity.
- 7. That the budget resolutions contained in the budget report be approved.
