

DSD MEC RESTORES DIGNITY TO A NEEDY FAMILY IN TZANEEN AS PART OF FREEDOM MONTH CELEBRATION.

As part of restoring dignity to the citizens of Limpopo during this Freedom Month, Limpopo MEC for Social Development Nkakareng Rakgoale will hand over a house to a needy family at Mopye village in the Tzaneen area. The Makhudu family of four persons has been living in a dilapidated mud structure for a number of years. The very same structure collapsed due to bad weather and they were forced to seek refuge from neighbours.

The family was identified as the most vulnerable by social workers and community development practitioners who were profiling families in the area when MEC Rakgoale was handing over school uniform to learners who have been identified as vulnerable in 2021. The house was donated by a good Samaritan who was approached by the department to assist in the dire situation.
