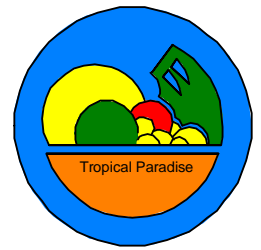

MAYOR AWARDS CLASS OF 2015 TOP ACHIEVERS IN GTM

The Mayor of Greater Tzaneen Municipality D.J Mmetle invited three top performing learners in each the 10 circuits under the Greater Tzaneen Municipality to join her for breakfast today, Monday (11/12/16) at Hotel@Tzaneen.

The Mayor pledged R5000 towards the registration for the top learner in each of the 10 circuits. Mayor also pledged R10 000 to Tzaneen Circuit for achieving 95.0% which makes it the best performing circuit in Tzaneen.

Tzaneen circuit also produced the Top learner in the Greater Tzaneen Municipality, Adrea Devenish from Merensky High School who obtained 92.3%.

Ritavi Circuit was awarded R5 000 for the most improved circuit for obtaining 85.84% which is a 6.84% improvement from last year's 79%.

Petanenge Secondary from Ritavi Circuit improved this year by 30% becoming the most improved school for achieving 93.75% from 68.6% last year. Two schools from Nkowankowa Circuit St Georges and Meridian achieved 100%.

The learners who passed with flying colours were recognized in the presence of their school principals, circuit managers and parents. The Mayor appreciated their hard work and support from their parents and schools before they took off to varsities.

Circuits that fall under the GTM are Shiluvane, Xihoko, N'wamitwa, Khujwana, Thabina, Mafarana, Mawa, Motupa, Ritavi, Nwanedzi and Tzaneen circuits.
