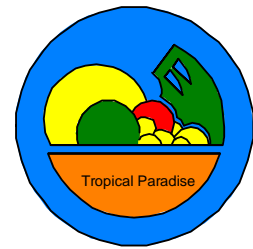

NEW RAMOTSHINYADI ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION COMPLETED

The Greater Tzaneen Municipality has invested around R73 Million on the construction of a road and bridge in Ramotshinyadi. The multi-million rand mega projects are just few of the municipality's capital projects aimed at intensifying service delivery in order to improve residents' lives.

The road which was budgeted for R52, 720, 600, 32 stretches from Ramotshinyadi to Merakoma and Ga-mokgwathi.

The 40 meters long Ramothsinyadi bridge which is built over the Merakoma River in Ramotshinyadi cost R23 million. It will connects Ga Mokgwati, Ga Wally, Lekgwareng, Mawa Block 8, 9&12, Miragoma, Radoo, Tzaneen, Ramotshinyadi and Giyani roads.

The new development will be beneficial to both motorists and pedestrians in the Greater Tzaneen area.

The road and the bridge are an answer to numerous grievances raised my residents in relation to their travelling conditions. This new development will certainly improve the travelling conditions and both residents and passersby. The community now has better and faster road access.

A number of jobs has been created due to the constructions, 33 local laborers were employed by the Tzandeboo Construction Company which was responsible for the construction of the Ramotshinyadi Bridge.

The construction of the projects which started on the 10th of May 2013 is now complete and the projects will be formally handed over to its beneficiaries by the Mayor of Greater Tzaneen Municipality Her Worship Dikeledi Mmetle on the 14th of September 2014.
