GTM TO HOST PROVINCIAL SAFETY & SECURITY SUMMMIT

The Greater Tzaneen Municipality will host the Limpopo Provincial Safety and Security summit on 28 and 29 November 2019 at Karibu Leisure Resort.

The Minister of Police General Bheki Cele , his deputy Cassel Mathale and Limpopo Premier Stanley Chupu Mathabatha are expected to attend the summit.
