

"TRADITIONAL LEADERS MUST BE INFORMED OF ALL DEVELOPMENTS" SAYS MAYOR

Addressing Councillors and traditional leaders at the Nyavana Tribal Office this morning, Mayor of Greater Tzaneen Municipality, His Worship Councillor Gerson Molapisane promised to bring traditional leaders on board whenever planning and implementing projects in their communities. Speaking to Hosi Mabunda, Mayor Molapisane said "You don't have to hear about developments happening in your jurisdiction in the grapevine, Councillors must first come to you or I will come"

The Mayor also acknowledged service delivery challenges faced by communities under the Nyavana Traditional Authority and promised to attend to them and engage other government entities where required.

The Mayor has been meeting with stakeholders since his election as the Mayor of the second largest municipality in Limpopo on 22 November 2021. He has already met with Kgosi Kgadi Maake and Kgosi Mogoboya. Next week the Mayor supported by the Speaker, Chief Whip and EXCO members will meet KGOSI Modjadji, Hosi Muhlava and Hosi Nwamitwa.
