TZANEEN DAM JETTY 3 IS OPEN FOR BOATS & FISHING

The Tzaneen Dam Jetty 3 is now open to any member of the public who wishes to use it to launch their boat/s and/or for fishing. Access will only be granted to individuals in possession of a permit issued by the municipality.

Jetty 3 will however remain closed for picnics to prevent the spread of covid-19. The municipality is also in a process of procuring management services for the facility on a long-term basis.

The permit can be obtained at Planning and Economic Development Department (Land and Human Settlement Division). Application/s for permission must be done in writing stating the particulars of the applicant and purpose. This permit is free and must be produced at the gate. No one will be allowed into the premises without a valid permit. Applicants must either have a skipper license or a fishing permit.

Please note that those who use Jetty 3 do so at their own risk and that the GTM will not be liable for any loss, damage, or injury.
