RESOLVED

- c) That all assets, liabilities, rights, and obligations of the entity vest in the Municipal Council of Greater Tzaneen.
- d) That all staff matters relating to the employees of GTEDA be handled in accordance to Section 197 of the Labour Relations Act;
- e) That the necessary consultations processes including the Transfer Process

 Plan be initiated by the Accounting Officer.
- f) That the Council approves the establishment of the municipal entity in line with the provisions of sections 76 (b) (i), 78 and 80 (1) (a) of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, 32 of 2000, as amended.
- g) That the Municipal Council must conduct an assessment of the financial implications in line with section 84 of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, 56, 2003.

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h) That GTEDA be extended for six months from October 2023 up to March 2024, and the Accounting Officer be given six months to finalize the disestablishment of GTEDA.

NOTE: That the Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF) supported the recommendations except recommendation (f). He further indicated that the municipality should allow the process of disestablishment to unfold and if it fits to establish the municipal entity, the municipality should consider the establishment of municipal entity.
