





them. This comes after a 40-yearold suspect was arrested by the Mpumalanga Hawks' Serious Corruption Investigation at Medupi power station in Lephalale, Limpopo province, for theft and corruption.

Allegedly, the suspect would impersonate an official from the Department of Health conducting a recruitment drive, reaching out to gatherings like churches, and other places where he could find unemployed youth in large numbers.

According to the Mpumalanga Hawks spokesperson, Capt. Dineo Sekgotodi, the suspect also hired two females who would go around recruiting and promising people enrolment at the Nursing Training College around Bushbuckridge which would guarantee employment at the Department of Health.

His two female companions were arrested last year, on the 10th of May, and appeared in the Bushbuckridge Magistrates' Court. They according to the police, more than 75 unemployed youth paid the money into the suspects' accounts in 2016 and 2017 totaling to a staggering R610 000.

Moreover, the victims were never employed as promised and that was when the matter was reported to the Hawks in 2018 and the subsequent investigations revealed that the suspects were not the employees of any department.

The 40-year-old suspect appeared in the Bushbuckridge Magistrates' Court on Wednesday, the 23rd of February this week, and he will be joined with his co-accused soon. At the time of going to print the court was still in session.

The Provincial Head of the Directorate for Priority Crime Investigation, Major General Zodwa Mokoena, applauded the team for the courage to pursue the suspect who was hiding in Limpopo. She further warned the public not to be deceived by anyone who will be demanding money promising them employments.

# PMC invests R20M in education

Palabora Mining Company has sponsored 153 local students with study bursaries which were announced on Friday last week.

In a statement issued by the communication manager, Abby Ledwaba, PMC remained alert to Covid-19 and to ensure compliance, the attendance was limited to one family member for each bursary recipient to comply with the conditions at the venue and the bursars attended the ceremony via a live streaming online service portal.

"PMC has over many years been a pillar in the community through sustaining the economy of Ba-Phalaborwa and today we have stepped forward to support skills development," stated Ledwaba. He also said the bursary program coordinated by Training Department will support learners with coverage of full tuition, residence, meals, a laptop, and book allowances at recognised institutions of higher in South Africa.

Three former bursary holders who are now employed by PMC, also shared their experiences and how they were able to overcome difficult odds in their homesteads.

Nyiko Khosa, a former bursar from Lulekani, who completed his BEng Tech in Metallurgy in December 2021 and joined the PMC Graduate program in January 2022 said that the bursary was a "great opportunity as it allowed me to complete my studies without a hassle. I am now able to help my family financially as my mother is a domestic worker and my father is a retrenched operator from one of our local contractors"

According to the mine, the community baseline study that was performed in consultation with stakeholders such as Ba-Phalaborwa Community Forum, the Department of Education, Ba-Phalaborwa municipality, and the Traditional Authorities has established a clarion call for the provision of bursaries.

"PMC is taking education and skills development to greater heights. I am urging all bursars to grab this opportunity with both hands and run with it. The world is evolving, and it requires education. Through this bursary, our bursars will be able to meet industry demand and requirements," stated Dennis Modise, Senior Manager at Human Resource.

Following the unrest from villagers living in Benfarm and Majeje on the outskirts of Phalaborwa, the Ba-Phalaborwa Mayor, Merriam Malatji, met with King Majeje, Mlungisi Ntsanwisi. Malatji, Ntsanwisi and other representatives of the communities in a bid to resolve some of the concerns raised by the residents.

The meeting came shortly after residents had strategically blocked off sections of the R71 in protest against King Maje, stating that he does not reside in Phalaborwa and threatened to only open the road once the King made an appearance.

The meeting was held last week at the Municipal Council Chamber, facilitated by the mayor, and it was resolved that the tribal offices that were meant to be moved to Prisca in Selwane would now be moved to Lulekani.

Malatji appealed to the Ba-Phalaborwa residents to not resort to violence whenever they encounter challenges but to engage the relevant authorities including her office which according to her is always open for community needs.

Malatji however, thanked Hosi Majeje, Mlungisi Ntsanwisi, and the community at large for their discipline and respect during the meeting. Committee (MPAC) led by the Chairperson, Pretus Mkhari, visited the Selwane and Mashishimale Sports Complex as part of its oversight role on Friday last week, 18th of February.

The main purpose of the MPAC is to exercise oversight over the executive functionaries of council and to ensure good governance in the municipality.

The municipality revealed that Mashishimale Sports Complex is fully completed and will be ready for public use 'very soon' while Selwane Sports Complex is only 2% shy of being complete, citing reasons as just "mere final touches to be made to complete the project".

The upgrading of the Tambo internal street in Namakgale, internal street in Lulekani Biko Extension, and Namakgale Stadium were among the projects visited.

The Chairperson of MPAC, Petrus Mkhari, expressed his satisfaction with the progress made on the completion of both Selwane and Mashishimale Sports Complex.

\*\*\*Editor's Comment: It escapes all reason that a group of residents can take it upon themselves to close off provincial roads and completely upturn the lives and livelihoods of an entire region and threaten the safety of whole communities without facing any prosecution.

### GTM website hacked

On Monday morning, a member of the public browsed through the documents section of the Greater Tzaneen Municipality's website when she noticed something very strange.

Instead of the usual drop-down menus containing links to bylaws, council minutes and performance agreements, the sight that greeted her was that of a tattooed skateboarder holding a pistol to his head wearing what appeared to be a cardboard cut-out of a smiley face emoji.

The image contained a caption that

declared "Hacked by Kareem" and a statement that read "Hello, [eligible] Justice cannot be for one side alone but must be for both. Tell me, what in your heart."

Neville Ndlala, the Head of Communications for the GTM, quickly investigated the matter and within a few hours the situation had been rectified and it appeared that the hack was stopped. At the time of going to print it was not established where the hack came from or why the specific section of the website was hacked, but we do know that this is the first time the municipality's site was hacked.

# BOERE IN POLITSI TAKEL KRAGKRISIS

Tien boerderye, twee bosbougroepe en die Groter Tzaneense Munisipaliteit (GTM) het saamgesnoer om die elektrisiteitsprobleme in die Politsi-omgewing uit te sorteer.

Niel Scholtz en Deon Jacobs van ZZ2 se elektriese afdeling het in 'n onderhoud met die Herald verduidelik dat dié projek reeds in Oktober 2021 begin is.

"Die rol wat ons vertolk is om namens die gemeenskap leiding te neem, die proses te fasiliteer om die instandhouding van die kragnetwerk te bewerkstellig," vertel Scholtz.

"Ons werk saam met GTM en skakel met hulle om uit te vind op watter dae en tye ons 'n gedeelte van 'n subseksie van Tzaneen se kragvoorsiening af kan sit vir instandhouding," voeg hy by.

Scholtz lig ook uit dat om só 'n projek te laat werk, dit belangrik is om inkoop van die gemeenskap te hê, te besef dat samewerking 'n ooreenstemming van belange is en dat daar geen vergoeding is nie.

Die hoofdoel van die projek is om te verseker dat kortsluitings voorkom word deur bome wat te naby aan die kraglyne is te sny en plantegroei te beheer. Dit word gedoen deur die GTM se riglyn van geen bome nege meter weerskante van die kraglyn toe te pas.

Rolspelers in die Politsivallei het mense, tyd, toerusing en voertuie beskikbaar gemaak vir die projek, hulle sluit in: ZZ2, Amorentia Landgoed, Altona-plase, Gubitz-boerdery, Spies-boerdery, Westfalia, Diggers Rest, Muller Familie Boerdery Trust, Basson-boerdery, Merensky Timbers en Safcol (Suid-Afrikaanse Bosbou Maatskappy Beperk).

Die groep ontmoet weekliks met tegnici van GTM om te beplan en vordering te bespreek.

"Tot op hede het ons al meer as 28km se kraglyne wat oorgroei was klaar skoongemaak, daar is nog ongeveer 15km uitstaande. Die eerste drie fases van die

projek is afgehandel en ons is tans besig met fase 4 op Triangle-plaas," vertel Jacobs.

Jacobs sê ten spyte van groot reënneerslae van meer as 300mm tydens die tropiese storm Ex-Ana einde Januarie, het Politsi se krag vir die grootste deel aangebly.

Alwin Fleischmann was deur ZZ2 die taak gegee om rekening te hou van hoeveel produksie-ure verloor word as gevolg van onderbrekings. Daarna het Scholtz en Jacobs het saam met Westfalia 'n opname gemaak van foute op die kraglyne wat hulle op 'n selfoontoepassing vasgelê het. Ongeveer 1100 ure se produktiwiteit is in die jaar verloor as gevolg van kragonderbrekings en die eerste opnames het 167 foute en kwelpunte uitgelig op die kragtoevoerlyne.

"Ons het daarna met GTM en met die ander boere en rolspelers in die omgewing ontmoet en 'n plan gemaak om saam te werk en die probleme uit te sorteer ten bate van die gemeenskap," vertel Scholtz.

Die afgelope vyf maande is die

hulpbronne van elke boer en bosbouer aangewend vir die projek, hetsy arbeid, voertuie of toerusting. Tegnici van GTM is in beheer geplaas van die reëlings rakende wanneer en waar lyne afgeskakel moes word om veilige ontbossing rondom die kraglyne

"Volgens die inwoners van Politsi is daar reeds 'n defnitiewe, positiewe verandering in die elektrisiteitstoevoer sedert die projek aangepak is," vertel Jacobs tydens die groep se vergadering op 22 Februarie.

"Daar is nog 'n paar kwelpunte, maar in die geheel is dit 'n groot wen, regdeur die Politsivallei," voeg hy by.

Calvin Ramadzuwa, 'n tegnikus van GTM het tydens die vergadering bevestig dat elektrisiëns en spanne van die GTM ook vinniger toegang tot- en makliker foute opdie lyne vind sedert die samewerkingsprojek aangepak is.
