EVALUATION OF BIDS

The evaluation of the bid will be conducted in two stages. First stage will be the assessment on functionality: Key personnel Experience (attach CV and Certified Qualification) – 20 Points, Proof of work experience (attach Appointment letters or order) - 40 Points, Plant and equipment (attach proof of ownership or lease agreement) – 30 points, Bank rating – 10 Points, and only bidders that obtain 70 points in functionality will be evaluated in terms of 90/10 Preference point scoring system, where 90 points will be allocated for price only and 10 points will be allocated based on the Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) status level of contributor. Contract period: 4 (four) months.
